

General Information

Thank you so much for volunteering to help Angeles Crest prepare for our summer camp season! We appreciate your willingness to give of your time and effort! Here are few important things to know before coming up to our Volunteer Work Day...

- 1. <u>Tools</u> If you can bring your own tools to the Work Day that is helpful. If you can't bring tools don't worry, the camp will have some there for you to use. Also, if you bring up your own tools please mark them clearly so we know who they belong to. Here is a list of some general tools that you can bring...hammer, drill, saw (hand and power), extension cords, rake, shovel, ladder, brush loppers/pruners, chain saw, weed-eater, brooms, leaf blower, paint brushes.
- 2. <u>Clothing & Gloves</u> Be sure to wear appropriate clothing for the work day. Wear clothing that can get dirty, get cement or paint on, etc. If you have a pair of work gloves please bring them. If not, the camp will provide some for you. Please do not wear sandals to work in but bring closed toes shoes or boots for safety purposes.
- 3. <u>Weather</u> The weather will most likely be warm during the work day on Saturday. Make sure you bring a hat and sunscreen for protection from the sun. However, it is always best to bring multiple layers of clothing as the weather can vary throughout the weekend. If you are staying overnight be sure to bring a sweatshirt or a jacket as it can get cool at night and in the mornings.
- 4. **Staying overnight** If you plan on staying overnight, you will need to bring your own bedding (sleeping bag, pillow, blankets, etc.) along with toiletries, towels and personal items.
- 5. <u>Meals</u> We will have meals covered for all day on Saturday including a continental breakfast on Saturday morning, as well as a full meal for lunch and dinner.
- 6. <u>Camp Store</u> We will have a time where we will open the camp store in order for you to purchase various Angeles Crest items such as; water bottles, hats, t-shirts, sweatshirts, stuffed animals, etc., that will be available for you.
- 7. <u>Project Sponsor</u> Because camp funds are limited, the sponsoring of a work project is a great way to help the camp.
